Notice of requirement to register with the police

You have been convicted of a sexual offence covered by Part 2 of the Sexual Offences Act 2003.

This means that you are now required by law to register with the police from 15 October 2021. The nominated police station is FORTH BANKS.

This requirement lasts for a period that will be specified when the case has been dealt with.

A summary of the registration requirements is given below. If you need further explanation or advice, you should contact a solicitor.

Warning

If you fail to comply with this requirement without a reasonable excuse, or give the police false information, you will commit an offence and you may be fined or sent to prison for up to five years.

The restrictions in this notice apply throughout the United Kingdom (England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland).

And the application applies, in accordance with section 100(2)(a) of the Sexual Offences Act 2003, for a hearing to take place on 15/10/2021 at 14:00 at North Tyneside Magistrates Court for an interim notification order to be made until the main application is determined. In accordance with section 97 of the Sexual Offences Act 2003.

Granted.

Defendant required to register with the police in accordance with the Sexual Offences Act 2003 from 15/10/2021 for a period that will be specified when the case has been dealt with. Nominated police station: FORTH BANKS.

Summary of the Notification Requirements

Initial notification

You must notify the police **within the next 3 days** (or if you are in custody within 3 days of your release):

- your name, any other names you use, your date of birth, your national insurance number and your home address (that is your sole or main residence in the United Kingdom or, if you have no such residence, any premises in the United Kingdom at which you regularly reside or stay);
- the dates or periods when you will reside in a household that includes a child under 18 years of age;
- your bank account, credit card and debit card details;
- the information contained within your passport or other identification document

Ongoing notification

Note that if you are already subject to the notification requirements because of a previous conviction, caution or finding for a relevant offence then it is not necessary to make another initial notification. However you will have to comply with the other notification requirements (including the requirement to notify the police within 3 days of any release from imprisonment, detention, service detention or detention in a hospital).

Please note, too, that if you are already subject to the notification requirements because of a previous conviction, caution or finding for a relevant offence

- and you are still currently serving the sentence received for the earlier offence then your notification period will be based on the combined length of the terms minus any overlapping period;
- in any other case you will have to comply with the notification requirements for the duration of the notification period which ends at the latest point in time.

You must notify these details to the police **every 12 months**, even if there has been no change to them. If you do not notify the police of the details of a sole or main residence, you must notify the police **weekly**.

Whilst you are subject to the notification requirements, you must notify the police of:

- any change of name or home address within 3 days of the date of any change;
- your intention to reside or stay for more than 12 hours at a household that includes a child under 18 years of age;
- any address where you reside or stay for 7 days or longer. This means either 7 days at a time or a total of 7 days in any 12 month period;
- any plans to travel abroad, not less than 7 days before your intended travel.

Duration

These requirements apply to you from 15 October 2021 and lasts for a period that will be specified when the case has been dealt with.
