Details of the concern:

POLICE ATTENDED 5 MAINSTONE CLOSE, CRAMLINGTON. THE REASON FOR THE VISIT IS THAT INFORMATION HAS COME TO LIGHT FROM AN INTERPOL GREEN NOTICE. THE INFORMATION WAS THAT PETER DUNN FROM THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND HAS A LOCATE TRACE IN PLACE. THIS IS BECAUSE PETER IS SUPPOSED TO BE ON A SEX OFFENDERS REGISTER DUE A PREVIOUS RAPE CONVICTION. PETER IS RESIDING AT THE ADDRESS WITH HIS PARTNER CHOI YENG GAN AND HER DAUGHTER REBECCA RU-YU GAN. CHOI YENG STATED THAT PETER IS RECECKAS BIOLOGICAL FATHER. THE PURPOSE OF THE VISIT WAS TO CHECK THE WELFARE OF REBECCA.

WHEN POLICE ATTENDED (AROUND HALF 11 AT NIGHT) PETER ANSWERED THE DOOR. HE WAS VISIBLY SHAKEN AND LOOKED CONCERNED. HE WAS INSTANTLY DEFENSIVE AND TOLD POLICE THEY WOULD NOT BE COMING INSIDE THE ADDRESS. I TOLD PETER THAT I WAS THERE TO SPEAK TO HIS WIFE. HE ASKED WHY AND HE WAS TOLD THAT THAT WAS NOT

FOR HIM TO KNOW AT THIS TIME. HE CALLED FOR HIS WIFE BUT THEN WOULD NOT GO INTO THE ADDRESS AND ALLOW OFFICERS TO SPEAK TO HIS WIFE ALONE. AFTER SOME TIME OF PETER TRYING TO CONTROL THE CONVERSATION POLICE STATED THAT IF HE DID NOT GO INSIDE THE CONVERSATION WOULD HAPPEN ANY WAY AND ON THE DOORSTEP FOR ALL TO HEAR. CHOI WAS INFORMED THAT THE VISIT WAS TO ESTABLISH THE WELFARE AND THAT THE REASON FOR THIS WAS DUE TO PETERS PAST. RECECKA THEN CAME TO THE DOOR. THIS ACTUALLY CALMED THE ENCOUNTER. REBECCA WENT INSIDE AND THE CONVERSATION CONTINUED. CHOI STATED SHE WAS AWARE OF A RAPE ALLEGATION IN PETERS PAST. SHE STATED THOUGH THAT THE ALLEGATIONS WERE FALSE AND THAT PETER HAD WRONGFULLY BEEN SENT TO PRISON. SHE STATED THAT THEY WERE IN THE PROCESS OF APPEALING THE CONVICTION. AFTER SOME TIME POLICE WERE INVITED IN TO THE ADDRESS. RECECKA APPEARED FIT AND WELL AND WAS VERY PLEASANT. SHE DID

NOT SAY ANYTHING WHICH RAISED ANY CONCERNS. CHOI APPEARED TO BE VERY UNDERSTANDING AND ATTEMPTED TO CALM PETER DOWN A NUMBER OF TIMES. THE HOUSE WAS IN A NICE ESTATE AND THE INSIDE APPEARED IN GOOD ORDER. FROM SPEAKING TO CHOI SHE IS AWARE OF PETERS PAST BUT DOES NOT BELIEVE THE ALLEGATIONS AND CONVICTION TO BE TRUE.

Details of the concern:

POLICE WERE CALLED BY CRAMLINGTON LEARNING VILLAGE WITH A CONCERN FOR PETER DUNNE. PETER HAD ATTENDED THE SCHOOL AND STATED THAT HE NEEDED TO TAKE HIS DAUGHTER AWAY FROM SCHOOL DUE TO THE FACT THAT HE IS A "TERRORIST TARGET" HE HAS THEN LEFT THE SCHOOL OF HIS OWN ACCORD. POLICE LATER ATTENDED THE H/A OF 25 MAINSTONE CLOSE AND REBECKA AND CHOI WERE OME ALONE. CHOI REFUSED TO ALLOW ENTRY TO THE POLICE UNTIL PETER RETURNED HOM APPROX 5 MINS LATER. WHEN PETER ATENDED, HE WAS EXTREMELY OBSTRUCTIVE AND DID NOT WISH TO ALLOW POLICE ENTRY TO HIS ADDRESS.

POLICE ENTERED UNDER SEC 17. THE HOUSE APPEARED TO BE RELATIVELY IN GOOD STATE HOPWEVER THERE WERE NO BEDS UP STAIRS, JUST MATRESSES ON THE FLOOR (WITH BEDDING ON). THE ROOMS WERE RELATIVELY SPARCE BUT LIVEABLE FOR A 14 YR OLD CHILD.

REBECKA APPEARED IN GOOD SPIRITS AND THERE WERE NO IMMEDIATE CONCERNS IN REGARDS TO HER.

PETER WAS ACTING ERRATICALLY AND KEPT BLAMING THE POLICE FOR HIM BEING A "TERRORIST TARGET".

PETER HAS RECENTLY BEEN SUMMONSED TO COURT IN ORDER TO GET HIM PUT ON THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTER HAS HE HAS PREVIOUSLY BEEN IN PRISON (IN RELAND) FOR RAPE. IT IS LIKELY THAT THIS CURRENT OUTBURST IS A RESPONSE TO HIS RECENT SUMMONS.

POLICE RECIEVED A REPORT OF A CONCERN FOR SAFETY AFTER REBECCAS SCHOOL INFORMED POLICE THAT REBECCA'S FATHER STATED SHE WOULD NOT BE GOING BACK TO SCHOOL AFTER POLICE ATTENDED THE ADDRESS YESTERDAY. POLICE ATTENDED THE H/A AND SPOKE TO PETER AT THE FRONT DOOR. PETER WAS VERY OBSTRUCTIVE AND ANTI POLICE, KEEPING OFFICERS AT THE DOOR AND REFUSING TO LET OFFICERS SPEAK. PETER STATED POLICE WERE JEOPARDISING HIS UPCOMING COURT APPEARANCE BY ATTENDING THE H/A AND SHOULD WE WISH TO SPEAK TO HIM, TO RETURN WITH A LAWYER. PETER STATED HIS DAUGHTER WOULD NOT BE GOING TO SCHOOL DUE TO THIS COURT CASE AND HE KEPT MENTIONING THAT HE ALSO HAS 3 NAMES AND 3 DATES OF BIRTH AND NOBODY KNOWS WHO HE IS. PETER ALSO REFERRED TO WEARING 3 BODY ARMOURS BUT HAD LOST ONE. HE CAME ACROSS VERY ANGRY AND WOULD NOT LET OFFICERS EXPLAIN THE REASON WHY THEY WERE THERE. PETER ALLOWED POLICE TO SEE REBECCA >>>

>>> AT THE FRONT DOOR AND SHE STATED SHE WAS FINE AND SPOKE TO OFFICERS. REBECCA WAS VERY QUIET BUT APPEARED FIT AND WELL AND DRESSED ACCORDINGLY. POLICE UPDATED THE SCHOOL WHO STATED REBECCA IS A QUIET GIRL AND THEY HAVE NOT SEEN ANY CHANGE IN HER BEHAVIOUR RECENTLY BUT THEY WERE CONCERNED WITH SOME OF THE COMMENTS MENTIONED BY HER FATHER.WHEN OFFICERS ATTENDED THE H/A PETER KEPT REFERRING TO OFFICERS THAT THEY WERE PUTTING HIS FAMILIES LIFE AT RISK BY ATTENDING AND KEPT REPEATING THAT POLICE HAVE NOW MADE LIVING IN THE UK UNTENABLE.

PETER, CHOI AND REBECCA HAVE RECENTLY MOVED THE TO AREA FROM COVENTRY. THERE HAS BEEN SOME CONCERNS RAISED AROUND PETERS RELATIONSHIP WITH REBECCA REBECCA IS 14 YEARS OLD, AND ITS BEEN OBSERVED THAT PETER WALKS HER TO SCHOOL HAND IN HAND.

PETER IS A CONVICTED SEX OFFENDER FROM IRELAND WHERE HE HAD BEEN GIVEN A 5 YEAR PRISON SENTENCE. THERE HAS ALSO BEEN ALLEGATIONS MADE AGAINST HIM IN THAILAND WHEN HE LIVED THERE. PETER HAS MOVED A LOT FROM DIFFERENT COUNTRIES AND WITHIN THE UK.

DUE TO PETERS CONSTANT MOVING AROUND, EACH LOCAL AUTHORITY HAVE LIMITED INFORMATION ON HIM.

PETER ATTENDED NORTH TYNE MAGS COURT ON 15/10/21 TO BE SERVED HIS SEX OFFENDER NOTICE, WHERE HE ALSO BROUGHT ALONG CHOI AND REBECCA. >>

NORTHUMBERLAND SOCIAL SERVICES HAD CONCERNS AROUND PETER'S RELATIONSHIP TOWARDS REBECCA, AND ANY ATTEMPTS TO ENGAGE WITH HIM AND HER WERE ALWAYS PREVENTED BY PETER. WHILE PETER WAS IN COURT SOCIAL SERVICES USED THAT TIME TO SPEAK WITH REBECCA ALONE.

DUE TO THE CONCERNS RAISED BY THE SCHOOL, PETERS SEX OFFENDER STATUS AND THE COMPLETE LACK OF ANY INFORMATION ON PETER, THE DECISION WAS MADE TO TAKE REBECCA INTO POLICE PROTECTION. THIS WAS IN ORDER FOR A FULL SAFEGUARDING ASSESSMENT TO BE CARRIED OUT.

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A summary of other relevant information held by Northumbria Police which may assist in your decision is provided as follows:

Incident 158 03/07/2021 – Child Concern C028666/21
Police Officers attended 5 Mainstone Close, Cramlington. This was in relation to information that came to light from an Interpol Green Notice (European Arrest Warrant). The information stated that Peter Dunn from the Republic of Ireland has a locate-trace in place. This is because Peter is supposed to be on a sex offender's register due a previous rape conviction but had fled Ireland without conforming to the requirements of the Sex Offenders Register. Peter is residing at the address with his partner Choi Yeng Gan and her daughter Rebecka Ru-yu Gan. Choi Yeng confirmed that Peter is Rebecka's biological father. The purpose of the visit was to check the welfare of Rebecka. When the police attended (around 11.30 pm) Peter answered the door. He appeared visibly shaken and looked concerned. He was instantly defensive and told officers they would not be coming inside the address. Peter was advised that officers were there to speak to his wife. Peter asked why and he was told that that was not for the police to disclose at that time. Peter called for his wife but then would not go into the address and allow officers to speak to his wife alone. After sometime of Peter trying to control the conversation police stated that if he did not go inside the conversation would happen anyway and on the doorstep for all to hear. Choi was informed that the visit was to establish the welfare of her daughter and that the reason for this was due to Peters past. Rebecka then came to the door which actually calmed the encounter. Rebecka

went inside and the conversation continued. Choi stated she was aware of a rape allegation in Peters past. She stated though that the allegations were false and that Peter had wrongfully been sent to prison. Choi stated that they were in the process of appealing the conviction. Rebecka appeared fit and well and was very pleasant. She did not say anything which raised any concerns. Choi appeared to be very understanding and attempted to calm Peter down a number of times. The house was in a nice estate and the inside appeared in good order. Choi is aware of Peter's past but does not believe the allegations and conviction to be true.

Note – This refers to Peter Dunne's conviction on 01/07/2001 for Sexual Activity with a Mentally Impaired Female Adult. On conviction Peter Dunne was made subject to the Sex Offenders Register

Incident 503 13/10/2021 – Child Concern C043708/21

The police were called by staff at Cramlington Learning Village expressing concern for Peter Dunne. Peter had attended the school and stated that he needed to take his daughter, Rebecka away from school due to the fact that he is a "terrorist target". Peter has then left the school of his own accord. Officers later attended the 25 Mainstone Close and spoke to Rebecka and Choi were home alone. Choi refused to allow entry to the police until Peter returned home approximately 5 minutes later. Peter was extremely obstructive and did not wish to allow officers entry to his address. Rebecka appeared in good spirits and there were no immediate concerns in regards to her wellbeing. Peter was acting erratically and kept blaming the police for him being a "terrorist target". Peter had recently been summoned to court in order to get him put on the sex offender register. He has previously been in prison (in Ireland) following a conviction for sexual offences. It was suspected that this current outburst is a response to his recent summons.

Incident 235 14/10/2021 – Child Concern C043803/21

The Police received a report expressing concern for the safety of Rebecka. The police were informed that Rebecka's father stated she would not be going back to school after police attended the address yesterday (see report above) Officers attended the families address and spoke to Peter Dunne at the front door. Peter was very obstructive and anti-police, keeping officers at the door and refusing to let officers speak. Peter stated police were jeopardising his upcoming court appearance by attending his home and should we wish to speak to him, to return with a lawyer. Peter stated his daughter would not be going to school due to this court case and he kept mentioning that he also has 3 names and 3 dates of birth and nobody knows who he is. Peter also referred to owning and wearing body armour. He came across very angry and would not let officers explain the reason for their visit. Peter allowed police to see Rebecka at the front door and she stated she was fine. Rebecka was very quiet but appeared fit and well and dressed accordingly. When officers attended the address Peter kept insinuating that officers were putting his family's life at risk by attending and kept repeating that police have now made living in the UK untenable.

Incident 508 15/10/2021 – Child Concern C044049/21

Peter, Choi and Rebecka have recently moved to the area from Coventry. There have been some concerns raised around Peter's relationship with Rebecka. Rebecka is 14 years old, and it's been observed that Peter walks her to school hand in hand. Peter is a convicted sex offender from Ireland where he had been given a 5 year prison sentence for sexual offences. There have also been allegations made against him in Thailand when he lived there. Peter has moved a lot between different countries and within the

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UK. Due to Peter's constant moving around, each local authority has limited information on him. Peter attended North Tyne Magistrates Court on 15/10/21 to be served his sex offender notice; he was in company with Choi and Rebecka. Northumberland social services have concerns around Peter's relationship with Rebecka, and any attempts to engage with him and Rebecka were always prevented by Peter. While Peter was in court social services used that time to speak with Rebecka alone. Due to the concerns raised by the school, Peter's sex offender status and the complete lack of any information on Peter, the decision was made to take Rebecka into police protection. This was in order for a full safeguarding assessment to be carried out.

Third party information:

22/11/2015 - Record from Warwickshire Police (Child Abuse)

Nathan is a 15yr old autistic child who previously (years ago) disclosed abuse by his father (Peter Dunne) to the police and social services, but according to mother nothing was done as he was too young to interview. Mum split with the father when child was 1, and in 2003 got a County Court order to stop him having contact with Nathan which was updated in 2006. It does not carry a power of arrest. Unbeknown to mum, father was convicted in 2007 in Kilkenny, Ireland, for having sex with a mentally impaired person. He was extradited from Britain in 2009 and imprisoned in Ireland. Since being released she does not know where he lives, but he appeared on her doorstep today stating he had a high court order over ruling the county court order about access to his son. Nathan is a vulnerable child. Mum is very concerned at the risk posed to her and Nathan by the father, Peter Ivan DUNNE (DOB 24/10/64), exacerbated by vague knowledge of his prison sentence.

Peter Dunne 24/10/64 - Information from West Midlands Police that Dunne holds an historic conviction from 8/2/84 in Enniscorthy (Republic of Ireland) for unlawful carnal knowledge of a girl under 15 years. Modis Operandi is to take girl u/15 that had learning difficulties and have sexual intercourse with her.
